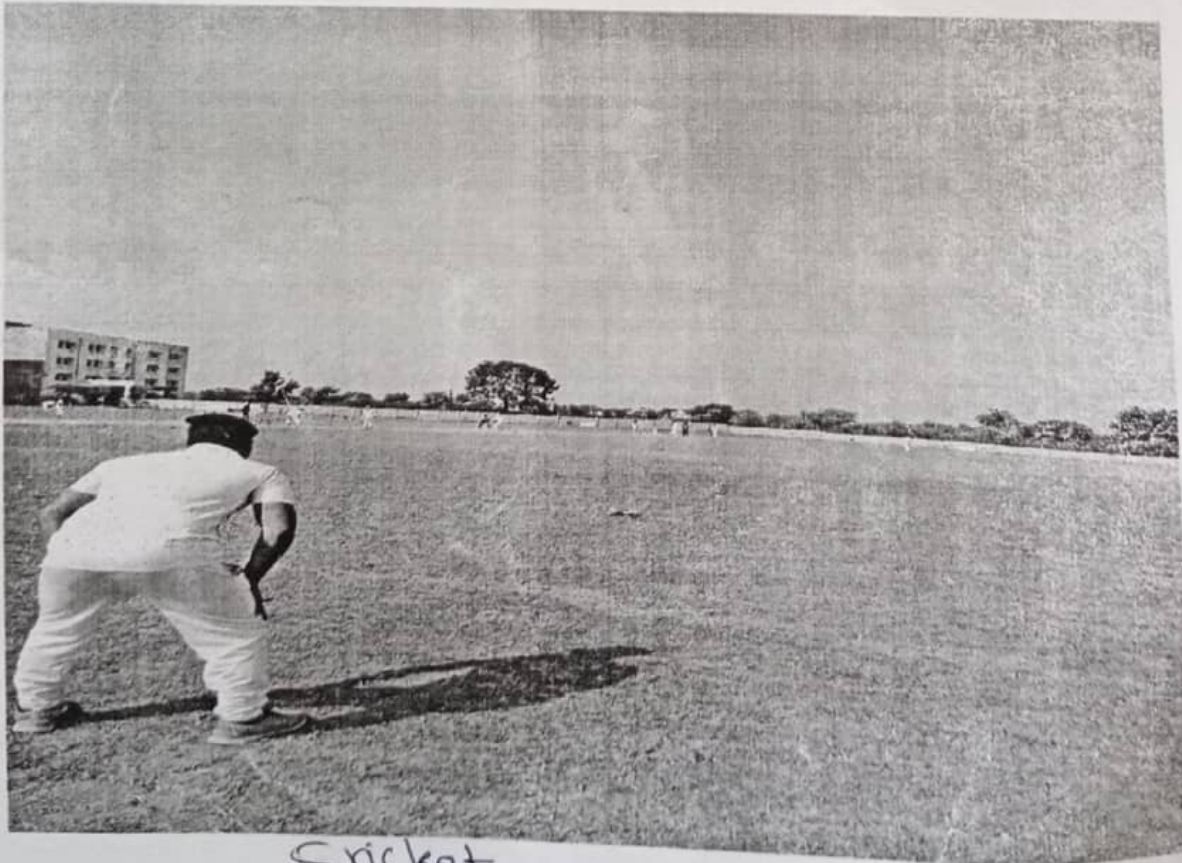
Annual sports event were having 04 different sports activities. Around 250 students participated in these sport activities.

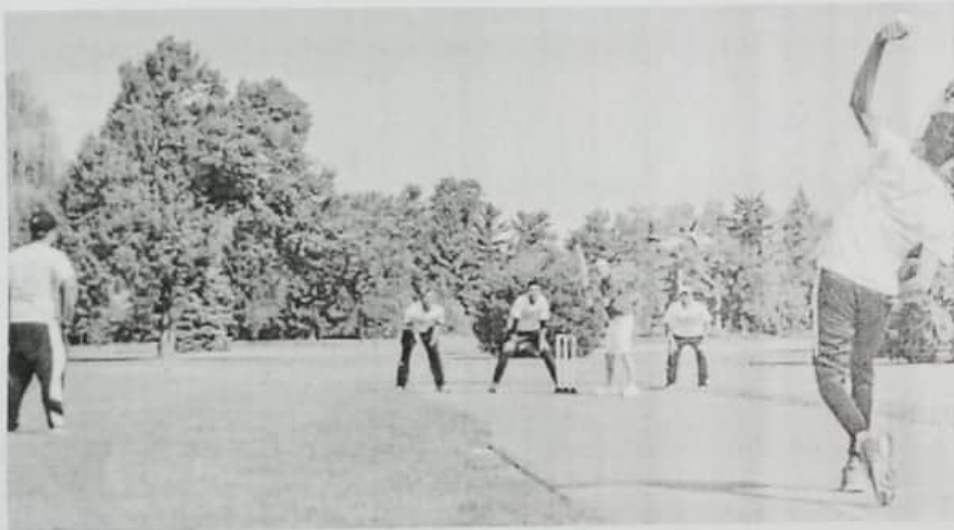
The primary objective of this celebration was to encourage students to actively participate in sports and games, emphasizing the importance of physical fitness and



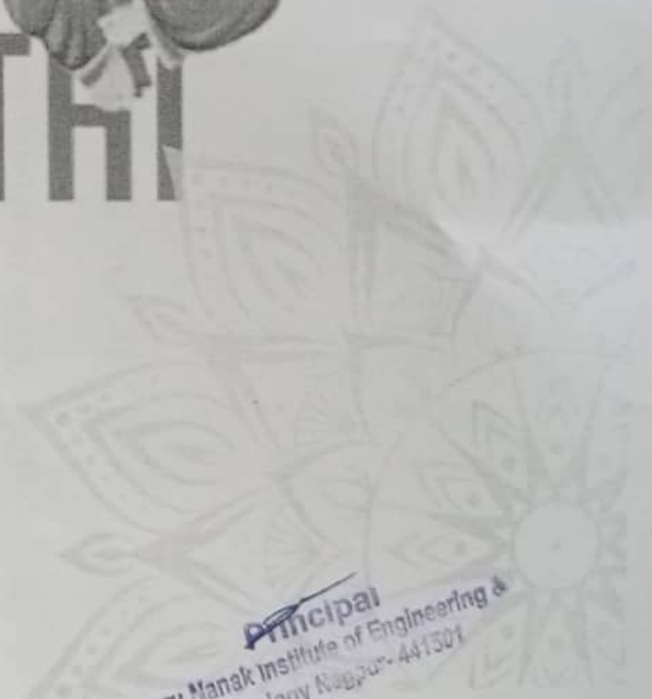

Day 1: Ganesh Chaturthi (19 September, 2022)


The festival begins with the installation of Lord Ganesha idols in homes and public places.

The festival fosters unity, cultural exchange, and a sense of belonging among people.


It is a time for feasting, socializing, and expressing devotion to Lord Ganesha.


Every participant outperformed themselves. All the performances were performed outstandingly, chief guests were overjoyed by all the performances. Everyone enjoyed a lot.


worship the Hindu goddess Amba, who is a form of Durga. Garba was originally performed by women only, but over time, men began to participate as well.

The Garba Night was a great way for students and faculty to come together and celebrate Gujarati culture. It was also a great opportunity for students to de-stress and have some fun.

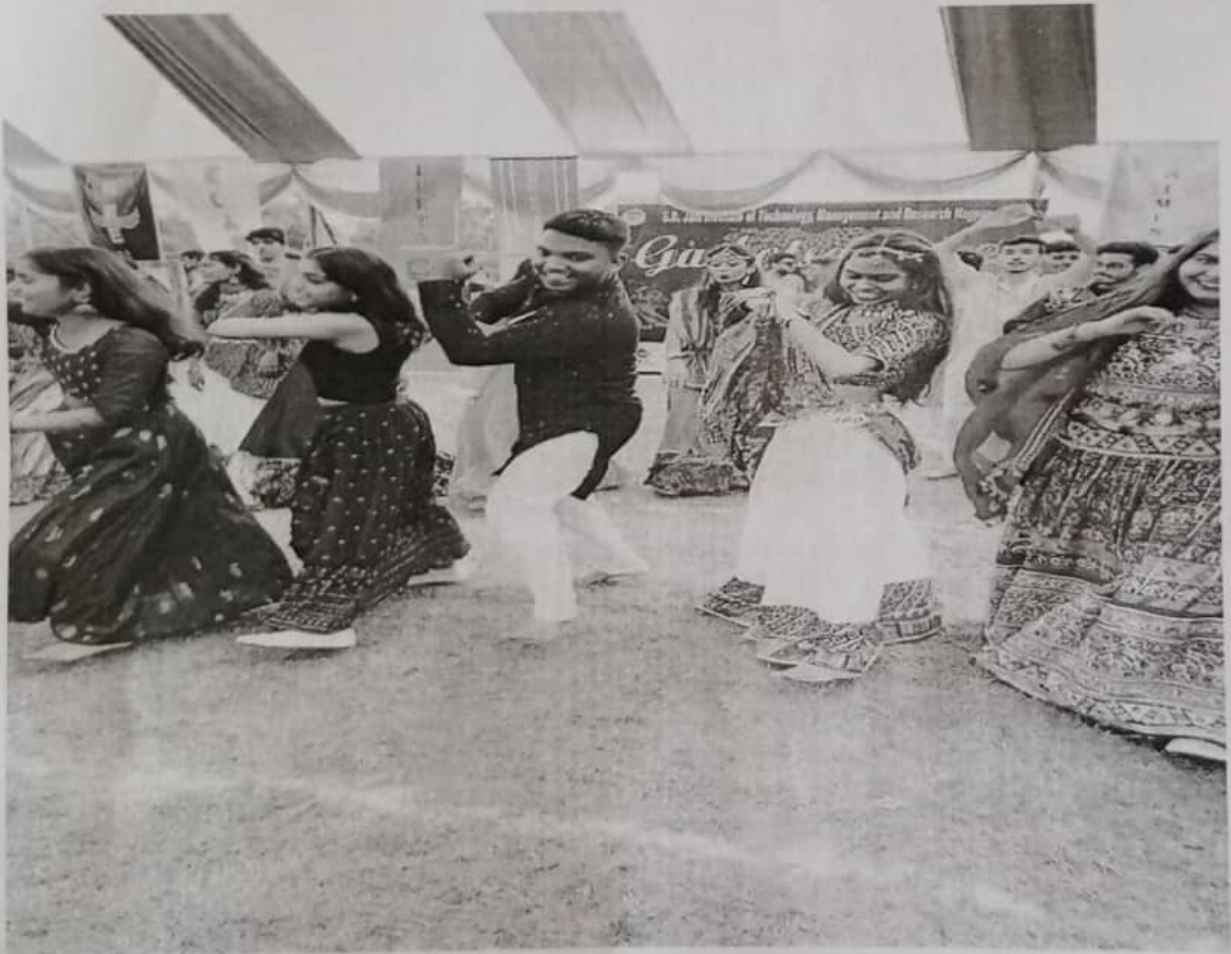

Advertisement Committee: The Advertisement Committee is in charge of promoting the forum's activities and events, enhancing its visibility and engagement with members or the public.


Discipline Committee: This committee focuses on maintaining order and ensuring that members adhere to the forum's rules and code of conduct.






