
1. To understand the framework for a solid intervention aimed to push the needle for girls' empowerment in developing contexts.

4. To address the issue of decline in girl child sex ratio and promote women's empowerment.


#### REPORT:




**Report on Awareness Workshop on Gender Sensitization.**

Event start with following activities-

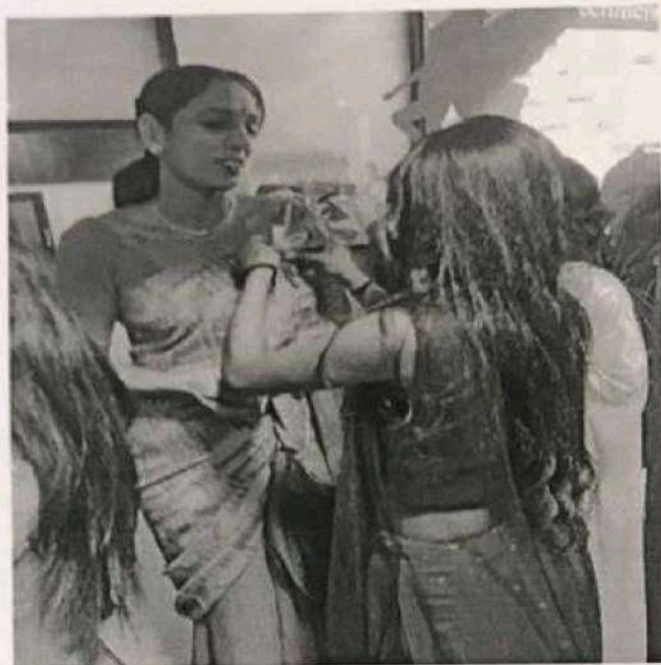
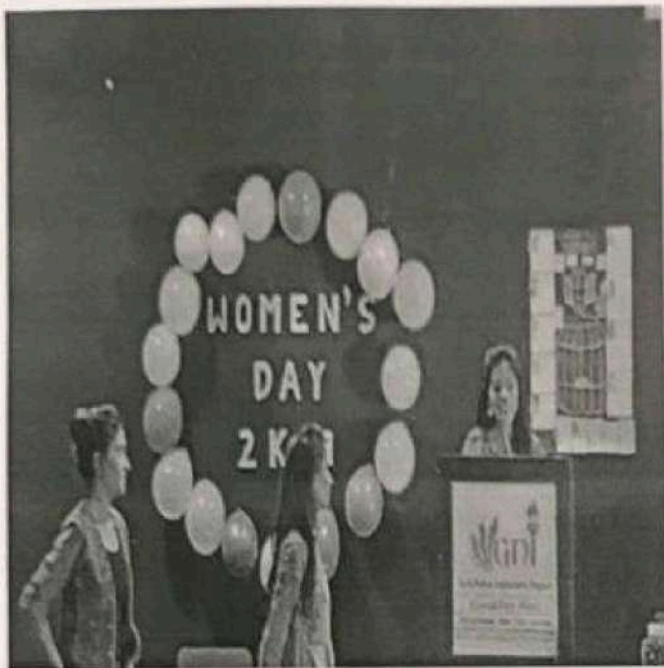
- First activity was representation of famous women by students. Students gave best introductions of famous personality women like Savitribai Phule, Anandi Gopal and many more.

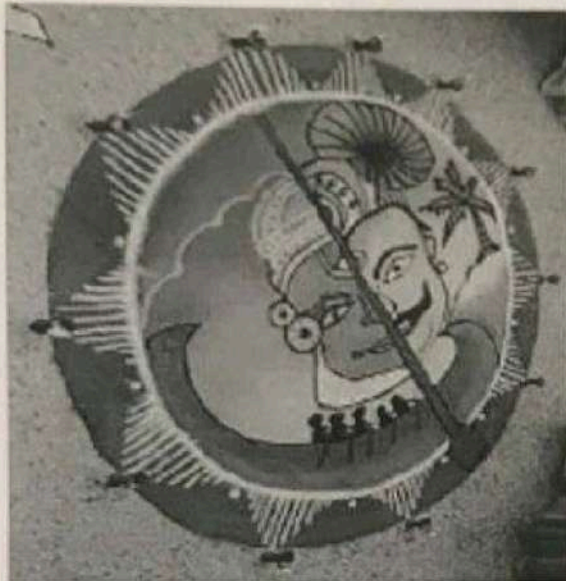

### "Report on Women's Empowerment"


A Seminar on topic "**Women's Empowerment**" was conducted by Prof. Fouziya Ansari, Faculty of 1<sup>st</sup> year dept, on 10/10/2019 for B.E 1<sup>st</sup> yr students in the A- 309 Lecture hall of T1 Building. A total of 100 students were present for the session. Mam started the topic with the introduction that, **Women's empowerment** is the process of empowering women and empowerment means accepting and allowing people (women) who are on the outside of the decision-making process into it. This puts a strong emphasis on participation in political structures and formal decision-making and, in the economic sphere, on the ability to obtain an income that enables participation in economic decision-making."

Empowerment is the process that creates power in individuals over their own lives, society, and in their communities. People are empowered when they are able to access the opportunities available to them without limitations and restrictions such as in education, profession and lifestyle. Feeling entitled to make your own decisions creates a sense of empowerment. Empowerment includes the action of raising the status of women through education, raising awareness, literacy, and training. Women's empowerment is all about equipping and allowing women to make life-determining decisions through the different problems in society. She further stated that Women's empowerment and achieving gender equality is essential for our society to ensure the sustainable development of the country. Many world leaders and scholars have argued that sustainable development is impossible without gender equality and women's empowerment. Sustainable development accepts environmental protection, social and economic development, and without women's empowerment, women wouldn't feel equally important to the process of development as men.

She further elaborated that though, it is widely believed that, the full participation of both men and women is critical for development, only acknowledging men's participation will not be beneficial to sustainable development.

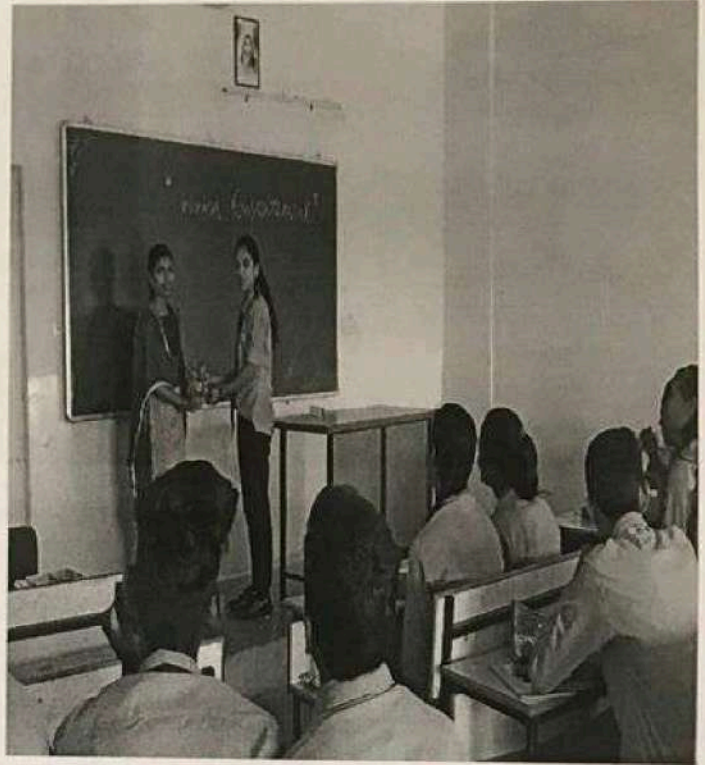
In the context of women and development, empowerment must include more choices for women to make on their own. Without gender equality and empowerment, the country could not be just, and social change wouldn't occur.

### Report on "Seminar on Professional Ethics"

A seminar on "Professional Ethics" was conducted by Prof. Sadaf Gauhar, dept of 1<sup>st</sup> year on thursday 19/09/2019 in Seminar Hall of T1 building. A total of 120 students were present for the session and it started at 11am sharp. The topic had three divisions namely the introduction, the briefings and the conclusion.

Mam particularly focused on how a person should groom oneself professionally and scale new heights in respective carrers. She further stated about the various dimensions one should acquire skillfully in any field which enhances self esteem and self awareness. The topics covered under the heading were:- What is profession, concepts of professional ethics, components of professional ethics and how to develop professional ethics. During the session, the students had queries, to which Professor replied very convincingly and effortlessly. Mam went on further and elaborated about the needs of professional ethics which an individual must imbibe into one's life for professionally sound carrer. Schools/ Colleges also implement a code of conduct for international study abroad programs. She gave one of the earliest examples of professional ethics is the Hippocratic oath to which medical professional/ docotrs still adhere to this day. She further stated and made students understand that professionals and those working in acknowledged professions exercise specialist knowledge and skill. How the use of this knowledge should be governed when providing a service to the public can be considered a moral issue and is termed professional ethics. And about the implementation mam said that most professionals have internally enforced codes of practice that members of the profession must follow to prevent exploitation of the client and to preserve the integrity and reputation of the profession.

This is not only for the benefit of the client but also for the benefit of those belonging to that profession. Disciplinary codes allow the profession to define a standard of conduct and ensure that individual practitioners meet this standard, by disciplining them from the professional body if they do not practice accordingly. This allows those professionals who act with a conscience to practice in the knowledge that they will not be undermined commercially by those who have fewer ethical qualms. It also maintains the public's trust in the profession, encouraging the public to continue seeking their services.

Thus the session covered all the necessary information which were needed to be learnt by the budding engineers to dwell into the ongoing/ continous process of professionalism.

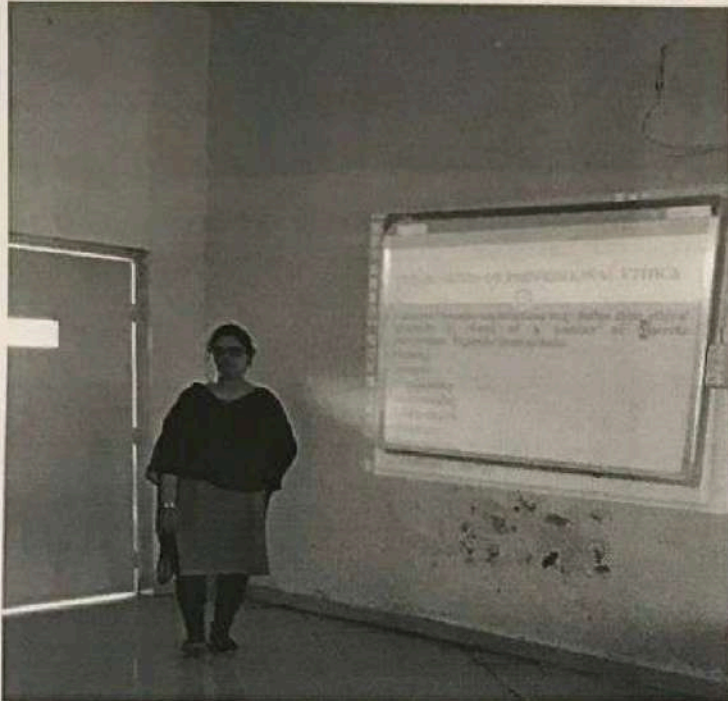



**Report of Vaccination Drive**



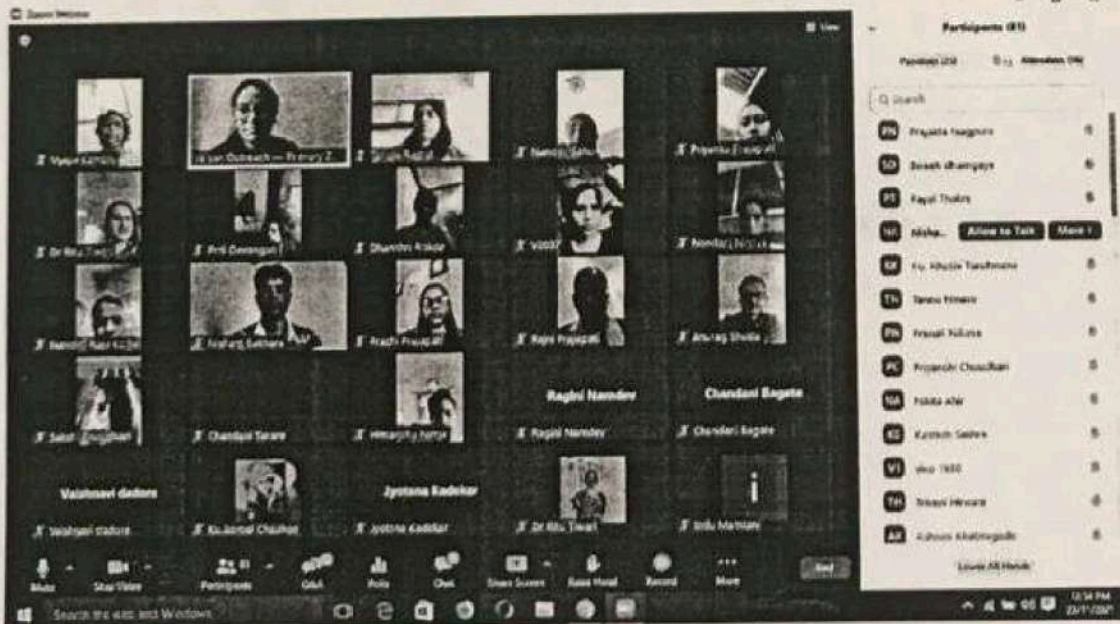


### **Women Day Celebration Report**

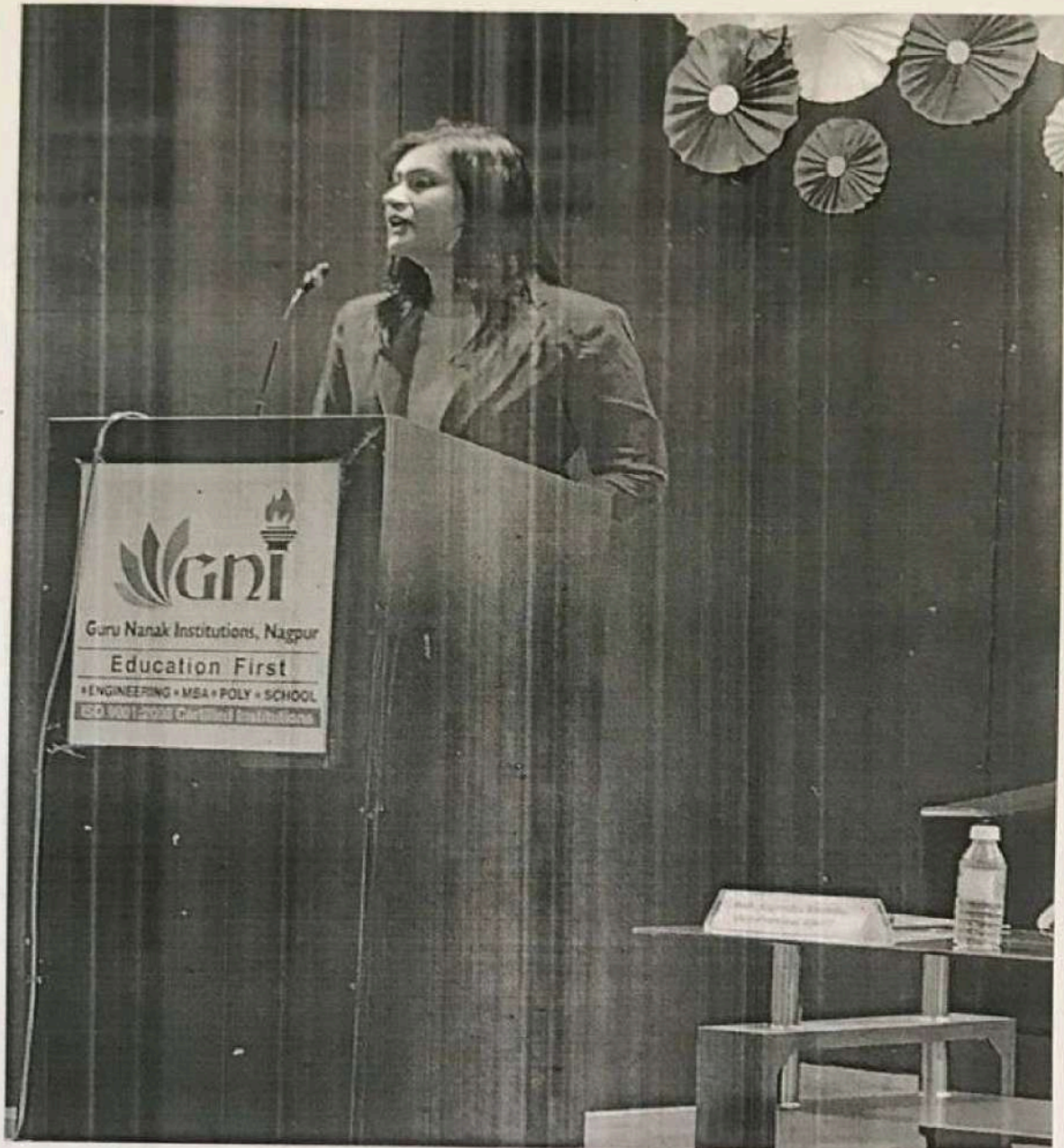



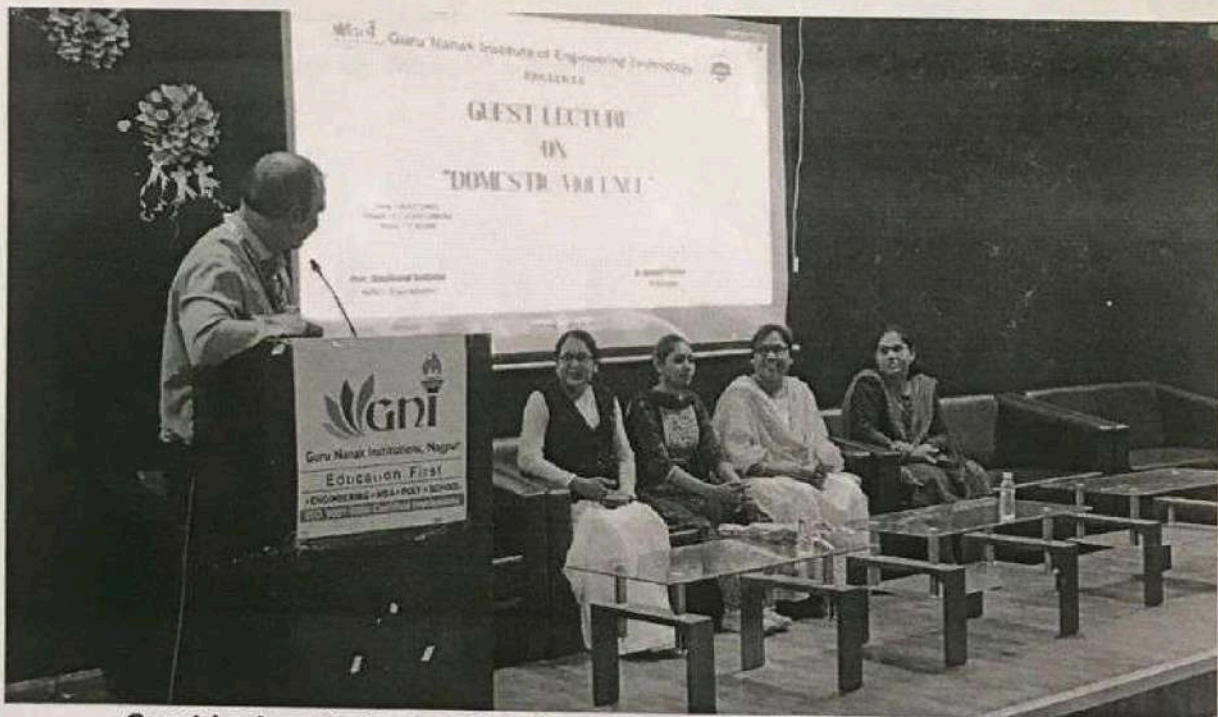
### **Report on Domestic Violence and Family Counseling**
